To ensure the logistics of your contest performance are as stress free as possible, here is a list of things to remember.

1. Email me an estimate of your chair and stand needs for the contest.
2. You will need 3 original scores (no photo copies) of each tune you are performing.
3. The scores will need to be numbered.
4. Make sure you have your updated Form 1 with you.
5. Students should arrive dressed in performance attire.
6. Buses/trucks will enter from the north parking lot but unload in the south (student) parking lot. (See map)
7. Bus/truck parking will be in the south (student) parking lot (See map)
8. Student holding will be in the practice gym just inside the building. (See map)
9. The Contest Office will be in the Choir Room. (See map)
10. Bands will warm-up and perform on stage.
11. Sight-reading will be held in the Band Hall (See map)
