Warm up areas will be marked off in the southwest part of the parking lot west of the stadium.

Buses and trucks will enter the stadium complex from Long Road. Parking workers will direct you to the designated parking area. Once unloaded, your buses and trucks will remain in the bus/truck lot until your departure. Please see the maps on the UIL Region 2 website for details.

Please be reminded of the following:

- Do not play while outside the designated warm-up areas.
- Please point brass, percussion, and metronomes away from the stadium while warming up.
- No one is allowed in the press box except contest officials and competing band directors.

Spectator parking is free and accessible from Long Road. There is no admission fee for this event. Remind your students and parents that all bands will be video recorded, so please keep the noise level as low as possible while bands are performing. In addition, please remind your students not to move into or out of the seating areas while bands are performing.
